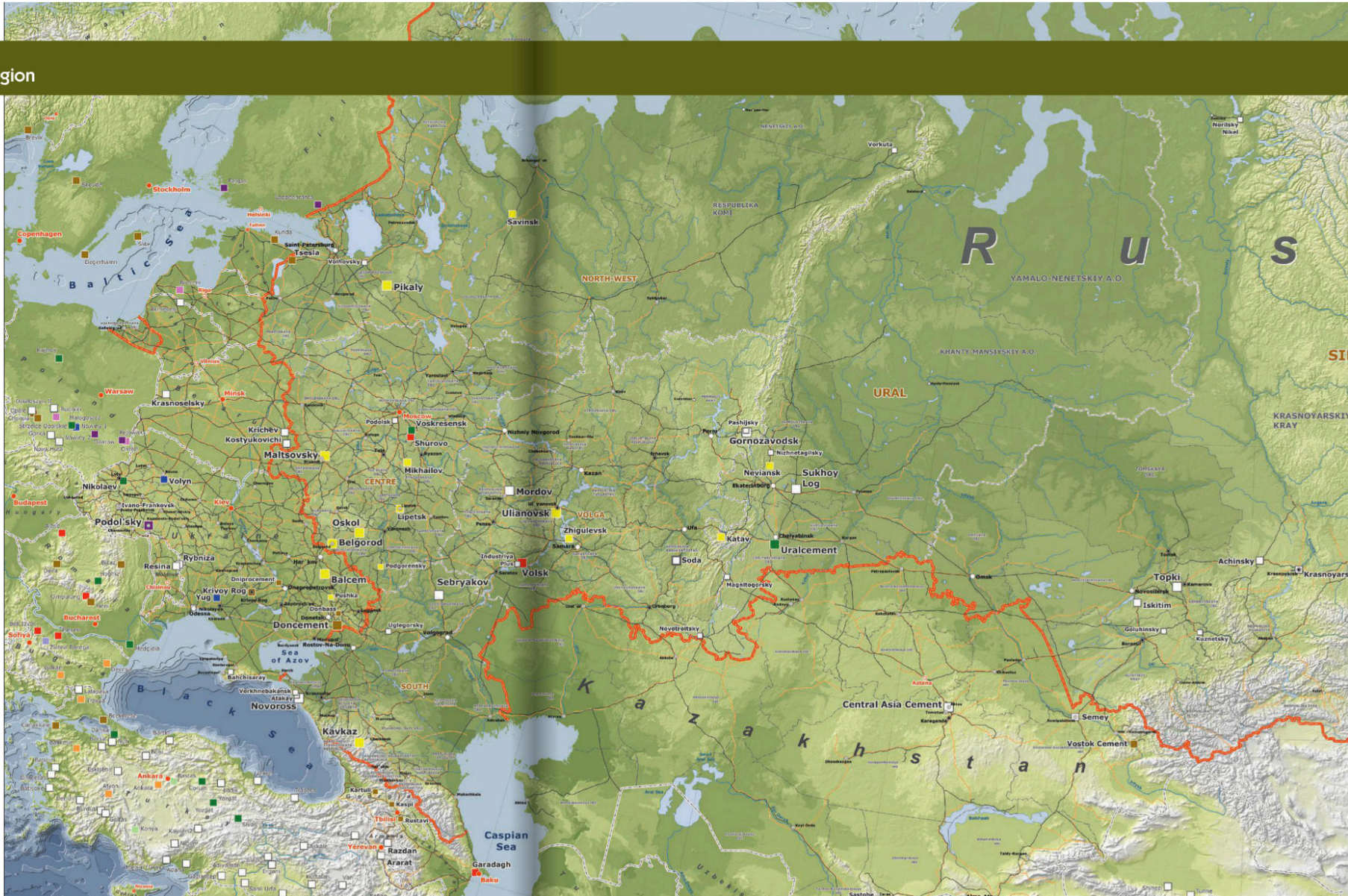

This map shows capacity and distribution of cement plants by owning holdings in Russia, Baltic, and CIS states by the end of 2008. It was made as a big graphic office wall map (250-by-150 centimeters) for Alfa Cement company. Alfa is the Russian representative of Holcim, one of the world's leading suppliers of cement and aggregates.

The map shows plants as big bright-color squares with their names in large type so the main content can be read at some distance, while the background can be read close up. The underwater relief is represented by illuminated contours to increase graphic impression.
